- Total sales reached an impressive 8,240 units, reaffirming our strong market presence.
- Sales of wheel loaders increased by 12%, reflecting growing demand and customer confidence.
- Value chain revenue grew by 12%, further strengthening business sustainability.
- Our Backhoe loader exports expanded into new territories, marking considerable progress in global outreach.
- Diversity within our workforce improved from 3.4% to 4.7%, with the addition of 28 Diversity Enhancement Trainees (DETs).

I want to take this opportunity to thank each one of you for your dedication, perseverance, and contribution to these achievements.

The past year has been filled with challenges and opportunities, and through your unwavering commitment, we have been able to achieve respectable sales volumes across machines, parts, and services. Let us continue striving for excellence, strengthening our market presence, and delivering greater value to our customers.

The past few months have been marked by significant milestones that reinforce our commitment to innovation, operational excellence, and customer focus. One of the key highlights was the inauguration of the Hitachi Development Centre at Dharwad, a step towards strengthening our Research and Development capabilities. Our participation in Bharat Mobility and STONA 2025, where we demonstrated our latest CEV 5 offerings along with other machines and attachments, further cemented Tata Hitachi's position as an industry leader. Additionally, the successful launch of the EX 350LC Prime in Mumbai has set new benchmarks in product excellence.

We have also made considerable progress across key business areas:

- Our value chain revenue increased by 10%, reinforcing business sustainability.
- We also achieved the highest-ever number of machine dispatches in March 2025.

Our pursuit of manufacturing excellence was recognised, with both Kharagpur and Dharwad plants receiving Gold Awards under the National Awards for Manufacturing Competitiveness (NAMC) by IRIM. The initiation of production for BS-V wheeled equipment and EX350 marks another significant milestone in our journey toward sustainability and technological leadership. Additionally, the GMD audit conducted by HCM showcased remarkable improvements, with the Kharagpur plant improving from 93.7% to 94% and Dharwad from 89.5% to 91.4%, leading to an overall score increase from 92.3% to 93.2%.

The inauguration of the state-of-the-art 3S integrated facility by Pavan Motors in Shimoga was another important step in strengthening our customer service network. This facility seamlessly integrates Sales, Service, and Spare Parts, ensuring a one-stop solution for our customers' needs.

Beyond business, our sense of community and collaboration was evident in events like Republic Day, Family Day, and Ekiden at our manufacturing facilities. Additionally, our festive celebrations and CSR initiatives, such as the cancer screening camp for municipal workers and livelihood training for rural women, demonstrate our commitment to social responsibility.

As we step into a new financial year, it is time to build on this momentum with renewed energy, innovation, and collaboration. The journey ahead presents us with new opportunities to strengthen our market leadership, enhance customer experience, and drive operational excellence.
