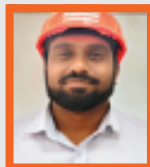

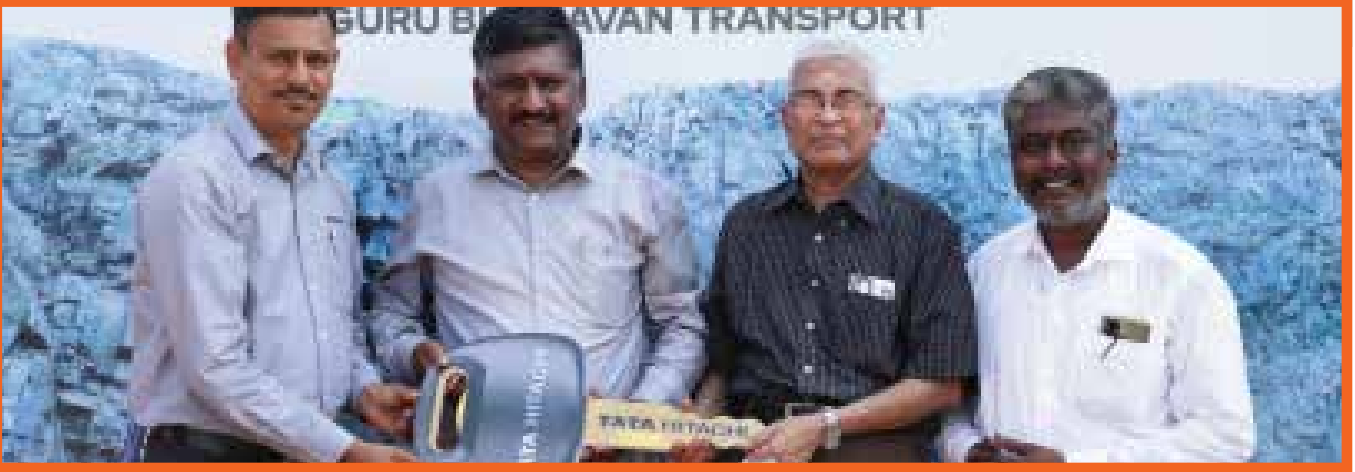
KLP Enterprises Key Handover
