Message from the MANAGING DIRECTOR



Dear Colleagues,

As we conclude the first quarter of the financial year, I am pleased to share that Tata Hitachi has delivered a stronger performance than the same period last year across our core businesses—Machines, Parts, and Service. This reflects the trust of our customers and the relentless commitment demonstrated by our teams across the organisation.

While our topline performance has been encouraging, profitability remained under pressure during the quarter owing to a sharp increase in commodity prices. We expect these costs to ease in the coming months and remain focused on driving operational efficiencies while continuing to deliver value to our customers.

The quarter also witnessed several significant milestones. We successfully held our Annual Business Strategy Meeting with the senior leadership team in Bengaluru, where we reviewed our previous year's performance and aligned on strategic priorities for the current financial year. This was followed by our Annual Dealer Business Conferences across Bengaluru, Delhi, and Kolkata, bringing together our dealer partners to strengthen collaboration, review business performance, and chart the roadmap for sustainable growth. The Annual Dealer Awards further celebrated

the outstanding contributions of our dealer network, reinforcing our shared commitment to excellence.

Innovation and manufacturing excellence continue to remain at the heart of our business. The successful field trial of the EX1200-7 during Q1 marks an important milestone, with the product scheduled to enter regular production in Q2. Another proud moment was the successful assembly of the first prototype of the EH1100 Dump Truck at our Kharagpur Plant, marking an important step in strengthening our mining portfolio. Equally inspiring was the achievement of the Hitachi EX2500-5 at Tata Steel's West Bokaro Division, which crossed an exceptional 121,111 operating hours—an enduring testament to the reliability, durability, and engineering excellence of our machines.

We also continued to strengthen our brand presence by participating in key industry platforms, including the INCOMEX 2026 Exhibition in North Karnataka and EARTHCON Expo in Hyderabad. These engagements provided valuable opportunities to connect with customers, partners, and industry stakeholders while showcasing our latest solutions and capabilities.

The global business environment continues to present challenges. Ongoing geopolitical tensions in West Asia have temporarily impacted machine exports to the Middle East, while the onset of the monsoon is expected to moderate domestic equipment demand in the coming months. However, these are familiar industry cycles, and we remain confident in our long-term strategy, operational resilience, and the strength of our people and partners.

As we move into the next quarter, let us continue to focus on safety, quality, customer centricity, innovation, and execution excellence. Together, we will navigate the challenges ahead and continue building a stronger Tata Hitachi.
